Who is this training for? This training is for non-Social Worker practitioners who will take on the role of on-site Practice Supervisor for a Social Work student, if the agency is using an offsite Practice Educator. You will be expected to have sufficient experience in your job role to be able to undertake the day to day supervision and guidance of the student – preferably but not necessarily with previous experience of supervising or inducting staff.

What does the training involve? The content of the two day course is as follows:

DAY 1 Preparation, Planning, Enabling Learning and Reflection including: the structure of the Social Work degree; an introduction to the assessment frameworks; the induction process; meeting students' additional needs; adult learning theories and reflective practice.

DAY 2 Supervision, Assessment and Dealing with Challenges including: principles of supervision; emotional intelligence; observations; assessment of capability and dealing with challenging students.

The event is free; it is expected that participants would be willing to supervise a UCLan student in an upcoming cohort.
