



### **#UCLanFreshers 2019 Competition – Terms and Conditions**

#### **WIN:**

**1 x up to £4000 towards living expenses (as outlined below)**

**1 x Microsoft Surface Pro Laptop**

1. For the avoidance of any doubt, the promoter of this competition is the University of Central Lancashire, Preston, PR1 2HE (“UCLan”).
2. The competition is open to prospective UCLan students who have accepted an unconditional offer for a full-time undergraduate degree course from UCLan commencing September 2019.
3. Parties directly connected to the running of the competition (including UCLan staff and/or exhibitors) are prohibited from entering the competition.
4. In order to enter the competition entrants must post a photo/video to Facebook, Twitter or Instagram with a brief caption using the hashtag #UCLanFreshers.
5. No purchase is required in order to enter the competition.
6. Entrants into this competition shall be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions upon entry.
7. Entries on behalf of another person or joint submissions will not be accepted.
8. We accept no responsibility for any entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected, incomplete or cannot be delivered for any technical reason or any other reasons.
9. The competition opens on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 at 7.00am BST and closes on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at 22.00pm BST. Any entries received outside of this period will not be accepted.
10. Any entrants under the age of 18 must obtain written parental or guardian consent to enter the competition and to claim a prize. UCLan reserves the right to ask a winner for proof of age.
11. Competition entries will be judged by a panel of 3 members based on the most creative entries.
12. The decision of the judging panel (acting reasonably) shall be final and no negotiation or correspondence shall be entered into regarding the judging panel’s decision.
13. UCLan will send the full names of the judges to any person who writes within 30 days of the closing date of the competition requesting details of the judges and who encloses a self-

addressed envelope to University of Central Lancashire, UCLan Welcome Team, Recruitment and Partnership, Edward Street, Chandler Building, Room 006, Preston, PR1 2HE.

14. The winners will be chosen by the judging panel in accordance with these terms and conditions. The winners will receive the following:
  - The first place winner will receive up to £4,000 (four thousand pounds) inclusive of VAT, if applicable towards their accommodation, travel or childcare expenses during 1 (one) academic year of their undergraduate degree course. (Please note that all travel expenses will only be paid against receipts provided to UCLan. If the winner chooses for the prize to cover their accommodation or childcare expenses, such expenses shall be paid directly to UCLan Halls of Residence or the UCLan Pre-School Centre respectively. The prize is not available as a cash lump sum.)
  - The second place winner will receive 1x Microsoft Pro Laptop.
  - Twenty third place winners will receive 1x £100 ASDA food voucher each.
15. UCLan reserves the right to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit of the competition.
16. The winners will be notified by no later than 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019, via direct message on the social media platform they used to enter the competition. If a winner does not respond within 28 days of being notified of their win, then the winner's prize shall be forfeited and we shall be entitled to select a new winner in accordance with the process set out above (such new winner shall also be subject to the obligations set out in this condition).
17. If a winner rejects their prize or their entry is found to be in breach of these Terms and Conditions, their prize shall be forfeited and we shall be entitled to select a new winner.
18. We accept no responsibility for any costs associated with the prizes that are not specifically and expressly included in the prizes.
19. In order to claim their prize, a winner must be fully enrolled on a UCLan undergraduate degree programme by 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019, based at Preston, Burnley or Westlakes campus. 20. The prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferrable and a cash alternative is not available.
21. We reserve the right to substitute a prize with another prize of similar value if the original prize becomes unavailable for any reason.
22. We may contact the winners by email about participating in publicity related to the competition. This may involve the publication of their name and photograph on the UCLan website and in any other media selected by UCLan.
23. The winners of the competition will be published on the UCLan website after 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
24. We will process any personal information you submit to us in compliance with data protection legislation. Any personal data you provide will be used for the purposes of administering the competition, publishing entries, notifying you if you win and for any publicity purposes involving competition winner as set out in these terms and conditions. This may involve publishing information on the University website or on social media which means it will be available to the

public, worldwide. We may also need to share some personal data with third parties to arrange the prize. We will use your information to contact you if you win. We will not use your contact details for marketing purposes and will not sell your details to third parties for marketing purposes. Your statutory rights are not affected.

28. UCLan does not claim any rights of ownership in your competition entry.

By entering this competition you agree that UCLan may make your competition entry available on its website <https://www.uclan.ac.uk/> and in any other media selected by UCLan from time to time in connection with any publicity relating to the competition. You agree to grant UCLan an irrevocable, worldwide, royalty free licence to use any and all intellectual property rights in your competition entry for the purposes of the competition, any publicity relating to the competition and for any other purpose that UCLan may see fit from time to time.
